## The Invisible Battle

Satan wants to destroy me. (v.8)

My Response: God wants me to stay focused. (v.8)

My response: God wants me to rest in His grace. (v.10)

God wants me to rest in His strength. (v.10)

## 1 Peter 5:8-14

<sup>8</sup> Be alert and of sober mind. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. <sup>9</sup> Resist him, standing firm in the faith, because you know that the family of believers throughout the world is undergoing the same kind of sufferings.

<sup>10</sup> And the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast. <sup>11</sup> To him be the power forever and ever. Amen.

<sup>12</sup> With the help of Silas, whom I regard as a faithful brother, I have written to you briefly, encouraging you and testifying that this is the true grace of God. Stand fast in it.
